Literacy involves reading fluency and comprehension. Reading fluency requires word attack skills to sound out words and break them into syllables. Reading comprehension requires the ability to understand words and go beyond the words to a deeper level of understanding. To accomplish that, you must ask yourself those critical thinking questions that enable you to understand character feelings/motivations, predict outcomes and integrate your own background knowledge with the text.
